EVALUATION

Reform Michigan's educator evaluation laws by reducing reliance on assessment data and focusing on feedback and growth rather than ratings.



MENTAL HEALTH

Expand student access to mental health supports by growing the pool of school mental health professionals, expanding access to onsite behavioral health services, and building capacity among community providers.



ASSESSMENT

Reform Michigan's state assessment system to reduce testing time, streamline assessment requirements, and expand state funding for assessments like AP and CLEP that are more relevant to students.
