APPLICATION FORM 2020 STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP

PLEASE READ THIS INFORMATION CAREFULLY, APPLICATIONS WILL BE AUTOMATICALLY REJECTED FOR NOT MEETING THIS CRITERIA AND/OR NOT FOLLOWING INSTRUCTIONS AS INDICATED.

PURPOSE:

The Michigan Association of Secondary School Principals (MASSP) awards scholarships to college-bound high school seniors based on demonstrated academic achievement, extra curricular activities, and school and community service.

CRITERIA:

- Graduating senior at a Michigan public high school or private high school with a minimum GPA of 3.0.
- Dependent of an MASSP member in good standing at the professional membership level or above for at least 3 years. Note: Children of MASSP staff or members of the selection committee are not eligible.
- Will attend a public community/junior college, four-year degree-granting institution, or vocational training institution that grants a degree, certification or license.
- Will be enrolled as a full-time student (at least 12 credits per semester/trimester).

RESULTS:

- · Scholarship recipients can expect to be notified of the outcome of their application by the last week of April.
- · Priority will be given on the basis of academic achievement, extra curricular activities, and school and community service.
- Scholarship determination will be made strictly on the merit of the applicant's performance against the above criteria. The selection and award of scholarships is an objective and nondiscriminatory process.
- Scholarships will be awarded by the members of the MASSP Scholarship Committee. This body is composed of current members of the MASSP Board of Directors and may additionally include MASSP members.

AMOUNT:

The amount and number of scholarships offered shall be determined each year by the MASSP Scholarship Committee. Recipients may only use the funds toward tuition and room/board costs. Payment will be made directly to the student's account at his/her education institution in August.

Three separate scholarships will be awarded to members of the class of 2020 in the amount of \$2,500 each.

APPLICATION:

Applicants must complete ALL sections of the application form. Do not put materials in any type of folder or portfolio, as it will be discarded. In addition, do not include any unnecessary documents with the form, such as photographs, news clippings or IRS/income tax information, as they will be disregarded.

DEADLINE:

The application form and supporting documents must be in MASSP's possession no later than the close of business on Monday, March 16, 2020. No fax or email materials are accepted. Deadline is strictly adhered to and will not be changed due to weather delays, snow days or power outages.

IMPORTANT NOTE:

Separated materials are NOT accepted. A complete packet must be submitted for consideration.

(e.g. Do not send individual letters of support. Gather all materials and submit them together.)

Completed principal/designee or counselor/college advisor statement (or included if on a separate sheet) along with signature requirement
Completed applicant signature requirement
